

**ATTACHMENT FOR CLASS I, II, III
TANNING FACILITY SERVICES**

Service companies, operator training, and sales persons in accordance with the North Carolina Regulations for Protection Against Radiation 10A NCAC 15 Section .1400, Tanning Equipment Services should notify their clients of the proper rules and regulations when purchasing tanning equipment, components or other services covered under the regulations for tanning facility use in North Carolina.

1. Each person acquiring or establishing a tanning facility shall apply to the agency for registration of such facility prior to beginning operations (10A NCAC 15 .1405)
2. Within 30 days after each calendar quarter a sales and/or installation report must be filed with the agency for each sale and/or installation of tanning equipment (sunlamp product, lamps, timers, etc.) in North Carolina.
3. Each tanning facility is required to prohibit any person or company from providing services until such person provides evidence that they are registered in North Carolina as a provider of tanning facility services. (10A NCAC 15 .1420)
4. Each person or company offering tanning operator training designed to meet the requirements of 10A NCAC 15 .1418(h) must have approval from the Division of Radiation Protection prior to conducting such training in North Carolina. All Tanning Operator Trainers must be listed below. The course schedules must be submitted quarterly. In addition, the names, and test scores of the participates in each course must be supplied to the Division at the end of each course.

Each sales person, installer, trainer, and/ or service provider must sign below. This includes, but is not limited, to individuals engaged in direct sale, telemarketing, and mail-order business.
